## Re: Human Remains Found This Summer

Major General Joe Ballard:

The Yakama Indian Nation hereby is placing a claim on the remains and the other five remains that were uncovered during the summer months in the Tri-Cities Area.

In the past there have been sites that had been designated and approved by the tribes in the past for reinternment of remains found in the area. The sites are: Ice Harbor located on the Snake River, West Richland relocated from Bateman Island.

In the best interest of the Native Americans it is requested that these remains be returned as promptly as possible for proper traditional Native American services. By returning these remains, the Corps of Engineers will be acting under the provisions of the Native American Grave and Repatrician Act and the American Indian Freedom of Religion Act.

In about 1994 Corps of Engineers had returned large amount of human remains and funerary items for reinternment, also Corps of Engineers returned the ownership to Native People of that region that re Federally recognized.
