Update on progress of work at the Kennewick Man site, for your information, as of this afternoon (8 April):

Construction:

- The rockfill/topsoil mixture is all in place.

- Placement of bioengineering materials (topsoil, mats, biologs, plantings) is about 40% complete.
- Anticipate completion of all helicopter placement activities on 10 April.
- Expect to complete bioengineering and cleanup by 15 April.

Public Affairs:

- Media turnout for 6 April was high volume, generally as expected
- print and broadcast-and most stories played heavily on the aspect of "Corps ignores Congress & scientists."
- PAO received almost a steady stream of calls on 7 April. The calls were from generally unhappy people concerned about our site protection work and to the greatest extent anonymous. Their questions and/or comments were rather consistent and at times seemed almost to have been planted, the language was so repetitive.
- Only two new calls from media today simply wanting status updates.
- No new warnings of protesters.
